Listed below is the salary matrix used for calculating salaries of lecturers/instructors and other part-time faculty teaching regular, overload, evening, and off-campus credit courses. Rates include a 4.0 percent salary matrix adjustment. Where applicable, rates have been rounded.

Salaries for teaching courses are listed per didactic hour. In laboratory or studio-type courses, didactic hours are computed on the basis of three contract hours equaling two didactic hours. No allowance is made for travel and reimbursement is not allowed for regular off-campus FTE.
